WORKSHOPS 2018 MARCH TO DECEMBER

These workshops will help you to develop your woodworking skills whilst providing habitats and feeders for Hyndburn's Wildlife – suitable for both beginners and those with some woodwork skills!

DATES	WORKSHOP TOPIC
24th March & 21st April	Garden Planter – to grow plants and herbs for wildlife and you to enjoy
May 5th & 19th	Flowering Bug House / Insect Home – bring beneficial insects to your garden
June 2nd & 30th	Butterfly Biomes – home and food station (summer and winter use)
July 14th & 28th	Bee Hotel / B&B – five star accommodation for pollinators
August 11th & 25th	Bird Table – hanging or wall mounted
September 8th & 22nd	Bat Box – somewhere safe to roost for these night-time creatures
October 6th & 27th	Hedgehog Box – give a hog a cosy home and somewhere to rest, hibernate and raise hoglets in your garden
November 3rd & 17th	Birds Nest Box – various birds – a safe home where they can roost and raise their chicks
December 1st	Simple Bird Feeder – ready for RSPB Big Garden Bird watch in January 2019

Please remember the Workshops and Activities are FREE to Hyndburn residents and there will be an opportunity to achieve an AQA Unit Scheme Award on several of the activities.
