



Membership Policy

The PROSPECTS Foundation is a registered charity and a Company Limited by Guarantee. It is a membership organisation, this membership system helps to ensure that the Foundation as a voluntary body, is accountable.

The Management Committee, which runs the organisation, is made up of individual members and elected representatives from member groups.

Who can be a member:

The PROSPECTS Foundation aims to reflect the community it serves and membership will be open to all organisations and individuals who support the aims and objectives of the Foundation.

Groups unlikely to be accepted as members:

Party political organisations whose objectives are not purely charitable or not consistent with the PROSPECTS Foundation's charitable objectives.
Religious organisations where the organisation is not involved in wider community activities or where the beliefs and activities are in conflict with the Foundation's charitable aims and Equal Opportunities Policy. (Most church, mosque and temple groups are also involved in community activities and therefore would be eligible.)

Any individual or group wishing to join the PROSPECTS Foundation will:

Agree with and support the aims and objectives of the PROSPECTS Foundation.

Agree with the Equal Opportunities Policy of the PROSPECTS Foundation.

Agree to the liability to pay £1 if the PROSPECTS Foundation ceases to exist (see Appendix).

Duly sign the membership application form (see Appendix).
