The volunteer will work alongside PROSPECTS Foundation staff and other volunteers as part of a small cycle team and will deliver six or more led bike rides and be supported by a member of staff.</p> <p>Bike Ride Leaders need to need to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Have an interested in cycling – beginners, intermediate and experienced; Develop an awareness of health and safety issues; Have some knowledge of emergency repairs and cycle maintenance; Plan routes, undertake risk assessments, lead rides; Undertake appropriate training – Bike Ride Leaders course (FREE); Be an individual affiliated member of Hyndburn CTC/Cycling UK; Be willing to learn new skills. <p>Successful applicants will be contacted by telephone before commencing cycling activities and training and invited to an informal interview.</p> <p>Leader courses help you to lead, support, guide and enable rides for all groups covering the differing requirements of adults, young people and children, and across the full range of novice to expert riders</p>
